#### **Primary sources**

- are original materials that are close to an event, and are often accounts written by people who are directly involved.
- offer an insider's view of any event





#### Secondary sources

- contain an author's analysis, evaluation, interpretation of the evidence, concepts, and ideas taken from primary sources
- rely on primary sources for their material, making analytic or evaluative claims about them.





#### **Tertiary sources**

 are publications that summarize primary and secondary sources.
