Tangrams



Tangram is a set of seven simple geometric shapes that can be arranged to create many fun and beautiful images.

WE WILL NEED THESE MATERIALS



Draw hatching lines on our tangram using sign pens to make them colorful. Give a different color to each individual shape. Don't forget to color on both sides.



Before we start playing, we need to know two important rules of tangram - while making images with tangram the shapes must not overlap with each other; and all 7 shapes must be used.

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CAN YOU ARRANGE THESE 7 SHAPES TO FORM A LARGE SQUARE? WE HAVE SOME MORE PUZZLES FOR YOU. CAN YOU ARRANGE YOUR TANGRAM TO CREATE THESE SHAPES?



Don't worry about being right or wrong here. There are more than one correct ways to do this.

Share your images with your friends and compare them. How are they different? What similarities did you find?
