

Images of people, animals, and objects that you can control and move using Scratch


Backdrop


Image of a scene or a place that serves as a background for sprites




Let's create some stories

Get sprites and backdrops to create a scene from the story you heard from your teacher.






2 Play with these tools to change size, or to or to rotate sprite

Show your scenes to your friends and look at what they have created.




Take pictures of your scenes
