Weeklong nationwide lockdown from today

Essential services will remain unaffected

The government has urged all emergency and essential services delivery agencies including security, food supply, electricity and garbage management, communication, customs, immigration, consular, among others, to function with minimum necessary staff during the lockdown period.

KATHMANDU, March 23

Hours after the government confirmed second case of coronavirus in the country on Monday, it took an extraordinary measure to enforce a countrywide lockdown across the country for week starting from today.

A meeting of the Council of Ministers on Monday decided to enforce a complete lockdown to contain further spread of the deadly virus that has already spread to 313 nations across the globe and claimed more than 15,000 lives.

Finance Minister Yulu Rai Bhattacharya, who is also the government's spokesperson, confirmed the government decision to impose a complete lockdown.

"In view of the risk COVID-19 spread across the country, the government of Nepal has decided to restrict some activities from April 1 on comprehensive basis until March 31 in accordance to the provision of the Infectious Diseases Act," said Minister for Health and Population Tharu Bhakta Dhakal.

After the female student, who had returned to Nepal on March 17, showed coronavirus-like symptoms, her third swab sample was sent to the National Public Health Laboratory (NPHL) and the result came positive, said Minister for Health and Population Tharu Bhakta Dhakal.

"After coming to Nepal, the female student was staying at home in self-quarantine. On Sunday she tested positive," said the minister, adding that the 19-year-old had come to Nepal via Doha transit.

Currently, the patient is admitted to the isolation ward of the Tika-based Bhatkhande Tropical Infectious Disease Hospital.

The committee on Monday also decided to deploy doctors from security forces, government and health facilities to the most

With a second case of COVID-19 recorded in Nepal this week, a bigger question is lurking: Is the public responsible enough to meet the virus's lethal mystery? Or is it too small a number to signal a larger, catastrophic? Opinions are divided among experts and officials.

What has left public health experts deeply worried is that Nepalis are not seriously taking the option to stay home and maintain physical distance to avert the chances of COVID-19 spread. All coronavirus tests being done by public health agencies and private labs around the world carry with a reagent called polymerase chain reaction, or PCR, which can detect tiny amount of a virus genome. Nepal's National Public Health Laboratory is also following the same method, which takes at least 2 days to give the result. The method also requires a large amount of reagents, which are very expensive, according to experts.

Important: contain the spread. Ordinary people are not on the alert and marketplaces due to their sheer ignorance of the risk associated with it," he said. "We may need to go for a total lockdown or a curfew in case of a community transmission."

Nepal is vulnerable to the pathogen for various reasons. Close proximity with China, thousands of Nepalis working in affected countries, spiking cases in India and continuous flow of passengers from affected countries have made Nepal vulnerable to COVID-19. The Oxford Journal of Travel Medicine has found Nepal as one of the 15 countries on high risk from COVID-19.

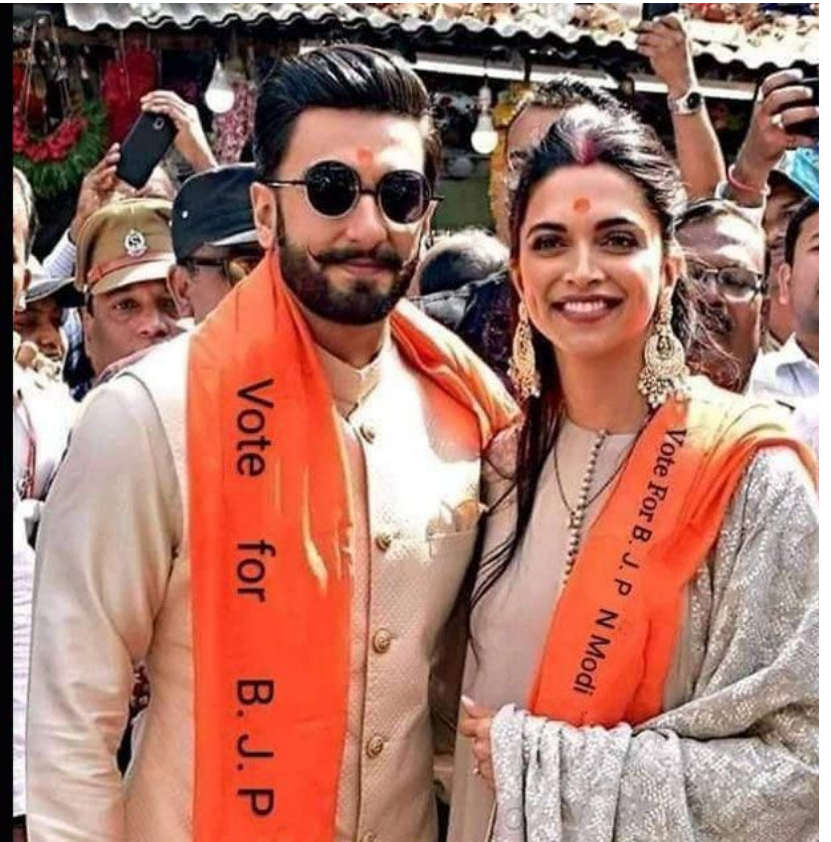
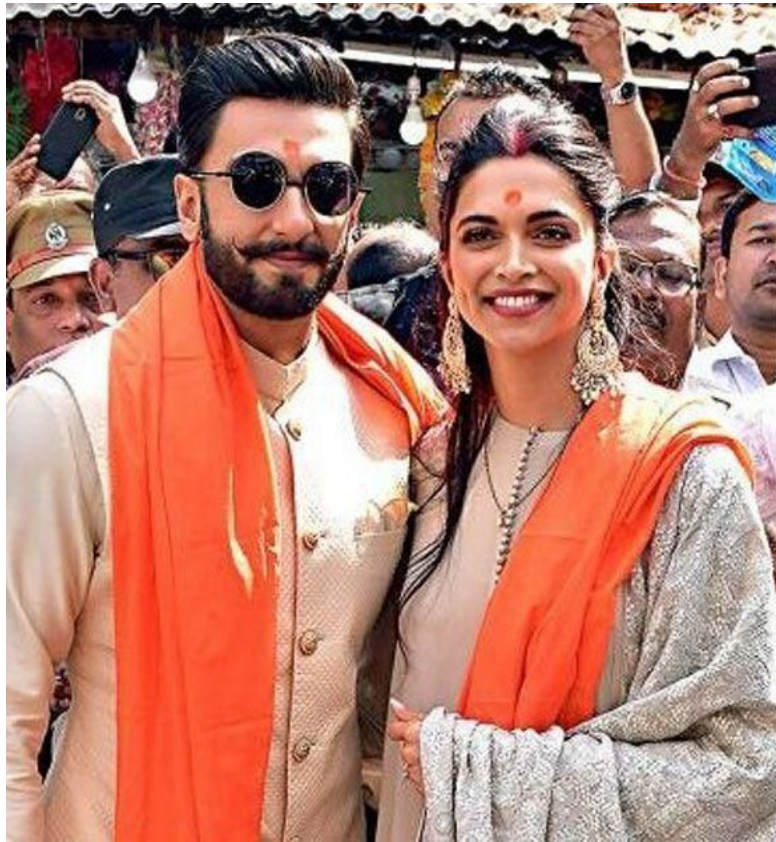
